Your toddler will need the following items:

- Sleeping Bag (cannot be a blanket)
- 1+ Week's worth of diapers & wipes
- 3 Extra Sets of Clothes
Please make sure you replenish their extra clothes as dirty ones are going home and/or as the seasons change!
- 1 Pair of Extra Shoes
- 1 Water Bottle or Sippy Cup (NO baby bottles) to be used for water only
- 1 Pacifier if needed
- Coat, Snow Pants, Boots, Hat, & Gloves from **November to April**
We are required to go outside daily for at least 15 minutes (unless temperature goes below 20 degrees fahrenheit with a wind chill)

Important Information:

- ALL sleeping bags and water bottles must go home on your child's last day of the week to be washed and brought back the following Monday.
- If bottles are brought in in the morning, they will be dumped, rinsed out, and placed by your child's cubby. Sippy cups/water bottles must only contain water.

Please make sure you have downloaded and are actively using the Procure App. We log all of the children's daily activities in the app and this is the best way for us to communicate with the parents. Please note that our first and main priority is caring for your children, so sometimes logs may be delayed and it may take time for us to respond to messages.
