## Sickness Policy

Dear Families,

To keep our center healthy, we must follow a strict sickness policy. If your child has any of the symptoms listed below, we strongly encourage you to keep them, and all other children from the same household home, to prevent their sickness from spreading. Not only is it important for the health of our children, but also for our staff and their families!

### Child will be sent home for any 1 symptom listed below:

- Fever of 101 or higher
- 3 Loose stools: Runny, watery, and/or bloody
- Vomiting: Including symptoms such as being unusually tired, pale, lack of appetite, confusion, and/or cranky
- Skin rash or frequent itching: Lice, rash, or any other spots that resemble childhood diseases, including ringworm, hands/foot/mouth, and pink eye

### Child will be sent home for any 2 or more symptoms listed below:

- Fever between 100.4 and 100.9
- Barking cough
- Constant coughing
- Wheezing
- Thick colored discharge from the nose

**The sick child and all other children that live in the same household MUST stay home the following day after being sent home. They may return only after 1 or more of the sick child's symptoms have resided and if no other children are showing similar symptoms. If the child had a fever of 100.4 or higher, they may not return until they have been fever free without fever reducing medication for 24 hours. If a child's symptoms are related to allergies, teething, or something else that is not contagious, please provide a doctor's note and your child may be allowed back upon the director's discretion.**

**Covid-19:** If your child has been exposed to someone that may have COVID-19, please keep them home until the person in question gets their test results back.

- If the test result is **negative** the child may return as normal.
- If the test result is **positive**, the child and all other members that live in the same household may not return. – UPDATED CDC GUIDELINES WILL BE FOLLOWED FOR A RETURN DATE. <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/if-you-were-exposed.html>
