When Sick children come into the center, they are not only exposing these symptoms to other children but also to our staff. Then before you know it, we have an outbreak of several sick children and staff.

To keep our center healthy, we will be strictly enforcing our sickness policy.

Sickness policy is as follows:

- Fever of 100.4 or higher: children will be sent home and may not return the next day. Child must be fever free without fever reducing medication for 24 hours.
- Two diarrheas: child will be sent home and may not return the following day or until stool is normal
- Vomiting: if your child vomits once, they will be sent home. Child may not return the following day and must be symptom free for 24 hours
- Barking like cough: child will be sent home and may not return until we have a doctor's note stating they are not contagious
- Constant coughing: child will be sent home and will need a doctor's note to return
- Rash on body: child will be sent home and may not return until we have a doctor's note stating that they are not contagious
- Wheezing: if child seems to be having a tough time breathing due to a cold, they will be sent home. They may not return until we have a doctor's not stating that they are not contagious.
- Thick colored discharge from the nose – may not return until the nose is cleared or has a doctor not saying they are not contagious

Child will be sent home for any 1 symptom stated above.

We understand that some children may have allergies, but we cannot take any chances.

If your child has been exposed to someone that may have COVID-19, please keep them home until the person who is in questions gets test results back.

- If the test result is negative the child may return as normal.
- If the test result is positive, the child may not return. – UPDATED CDC GUIDLINES WILL BE FOLLOWED FOR RETURN DATE.
